Code of Conduct: Developing and maintaining a code of conduct for students and staff, which outlines expected behavior, consequences for violations, and procedures for addressing disciplinary issues.

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Parent Teacher Communication: Keeping parents and teachers informed about disciplinary matters, as well as involving them in the resolution process when necessary.

Reporting: Documenting disciplinary cases, interventions, and outcomes for future reference and reporting to the school administration or the CBSE authorities if necessary.


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
